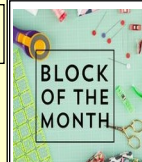

**LUNCH HOUR EMBROIDERY** - 130 playful motifs from A-Z, includes a complete alphabet.

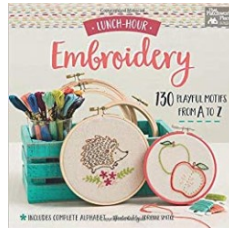

The **block** is an unfinished 10 1/2 inch **log cabin block** made in reds and whites representing Canada with a yellow centre representing a light in the window/welcome **home**. Our QoV representative, Elizabeth V. will collect these blocks. There will be a table to drop them off when you come to the meetings.

### Fabric Requirements for one block:

#### Yellow

1 - 2 1/2" square for center (#1)

#### White:

1 - 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" (#4)

1 - 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" (#5)

1 - 2 1/2" X 8 1/2" (#8)

1 - 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" (#9)

#### Red:

2 1/2" square (#2)

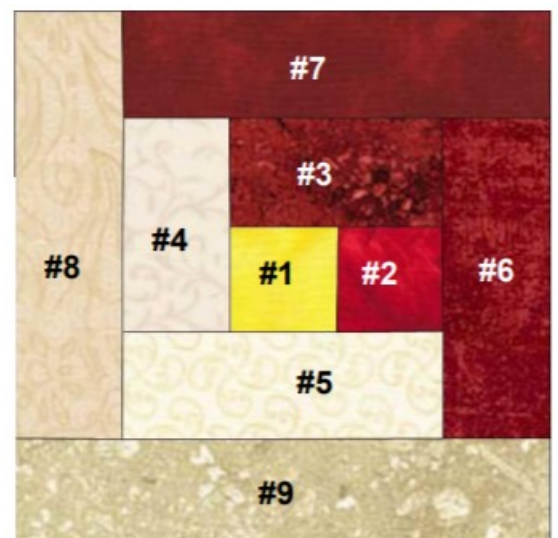
1 - 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" (#3)

1 - 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" (#6)

1 - 2 1/2" X 8 1/2" (#7)

1/4" seam allowance used.

8 rows of 6 blocks (48 blocks) will give you a quilt approximately 60" X 80". No borders needed, just layer, quilt and bind.

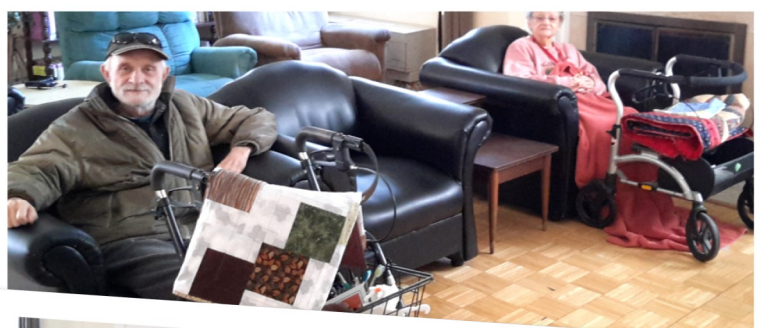

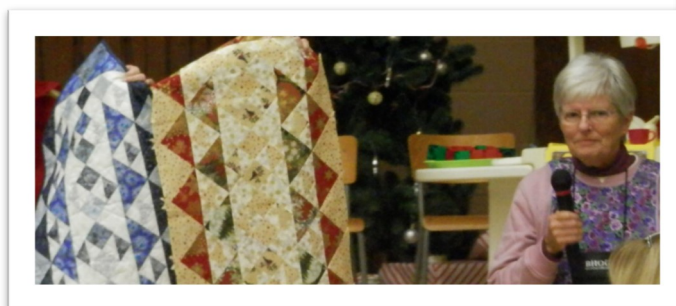
