Then you fill in another the slip of paper with the names of those whose names you have drawn and give this to Jane so she can file it for reference. THIS DOES HAVE TO BE A COMMITMENT ON YOUR PART. If you want to participate but won't be at the December meeting please let Jane know ahead of time so she can fill it in for you and then draw out of the bag the names to whom you will send cards to. JANUARY - Bring your favourite stamp or die. It will be given to someone else to make a card and the person who makes it will get to keep the card. This does mean you will have to bring a good supply of items. (We did this several years ago only we brought a stamp that we didn't know how to use it! The person who got it had to come up with an idea how to use it. It proved to be a very interesting meeting.)
