Dr. Elizabeth Pinnington

Dr. Elizabeth Pinnington is a Principal with Reos Partners, an international social enterprise that helps people move forward together on their most important and intractable issues. Reos teams design, facilitate, and guide processes that enable groups of stakeholders—even those who don't agree with or trust one another—to make progress on their toughest challenges.

Elizabeth specializes in highly complex socio-political environments. Her current and recent project portfolio includes: reforming the energy sector in Puerto Rico in the aftermath of Hurricane Maria, supporting the peace process in Colombia and redesigning the primary education system in Mexico.

She has worked in 15 countries and four languages—English, French, Spanish and Portuguese—supporting people from multiple institutions to collaborate on change initiatives. Elizabeth holds a Bachelor's degree from the University of British Columbia and a Doctorate from the University of Toronto.

Dr. Pinnington will be speaking about using collaborative approaches to resolving international conflict.
