Helen has worked in libraries for many years. She holds a master's degree in Library and Information Science from the University of Western Ontario and an Executive Management Leadership Certificate from the DeGroote School of Business.

A strong leader and advocate for children's literacy, Helen was awarded the Hamilton Individual Early Literacy Education Award in 2008 while working at the Hamilton Public Library.

In 2009, Cambridge Libraries & Galleries welcomed Helen as Coordinator of Children's Services. Her enthusiastic approach to innovation saw many positive results including a 26% increase in chil-

dren's program attendance over a 4 year period. In 2012, the library also received peer recognition under her direction winning first place in the national TD Summer Reading Club Library Award competition.

In her current role as the CEO at Cambridge Libraries, now Idea Exchange, she has had the privilege of leading a creative team of dynamic and engaged staff. Under her leadership, the organization has been recognized as a 2017 Aon Best Small Medium Canadian Employer.
