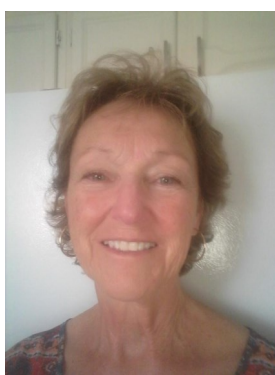

As I know many of you through travelling experiences, I am excited to meet even more of you this year.

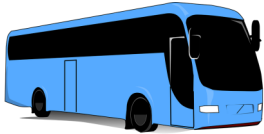
Our club has a wonderful range of activities (bridge, bowling, book clubs, and many more) for you to participate in this year. If you would like to start a new club or activity, please share with me.

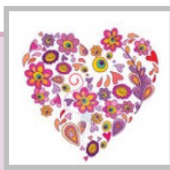
