## **FEBRUARY'S GUEST SPEAKER**

Paul F. J. Eagles, Ph.D., R.P.P, M.C.I.P.

Paul F. J. Eagles is a Distinguished Professor Emeritus at the University of Waterloo, Waterloo, Canada. He retired in 2014. His primary appointment was to the Department of Recreation and Leisure Studies, with cross appointment to the School of Planning. He specializes in environmental, recreation and tourism planning, with 45 years of planning experience. He undertook planning and research in these fields in over 40 countries and has 432 publications, of which 142 are refereed. These publications have been cited 9297 times according to Google Scholar.
