Meeting Minutes – March 3, 2025



The meeting was called to order by Shirley Kellar at 6:30 pm. Shirley welcomed everyone - there were 26 Members and 2 guests, 1 of whom later joined the Guild.

Minutes from February 3, 2025, were accepted. Motion made by Terri, seconded by Sherra. Carried.

Correspondence – Condolence cards sent to Ann Tchegus and Lucy Dudych on the loss of their Mother. They thanked us for our concerns.

Kathleen gave the Treasurer's Report – we currently have \$5,848.21 in our account.

The quilt that the Guild is donating for a new vehicle for Senior Support Service fundraiser is in the cupboard. Shirley & Jayne to take care of it after tonight's meeting.

Shirley did the label for Tricia for the S.S.S. for their fundraiser for a new van.

Sherra spoke about the planned retreat for Paper Piecing March 22 and 29 at HUC. She needs the registration fees paid for all the people who have signed up.

Ann J – regarding the Tiny Quilts – new ideas were sent out today.

Tricia – Mug rugs done – thank you! Tricia & Terri working on table favours. They are working at Tricia's house, Thursday & Friday following tonight's meeting, to get them ready for the Tea. Susan and Shirley to help Friday afternoon. Gail and Ann to help all day Friday. Betty Ann will be back in time for Sew Day in April.

Kathy - Walk-Around Haldimand – December's total was 22.95 km. February added 3.3 km, for a total of 919,000". Linda Miller added 618" for March. BOM – Leaves – Rita and Nancy had blocks to show. Next month there may be a problem with plain/patterned fabric used in leaves. Use your best judgement. Two blocks to be done for next month, and 2 blocks for the month after that.

Quilts to be displayed at the Tea – we need to make a list for April.

Sandra – log cabin block exchange – if you need more for your chosen layout, bring more packets of 10 per month.

Zoey spoke about the wearables we can order. March 17 Sew Day will be the last day to order. Cash only.

Good news – Shirley was able to get the insurance required to have a booth at Ag Day celebration of Hagersville's 150th anniversary, only \$27 for a year. Motion to have a booth at Ag Day made by Tricia, seconded by Nadine. Carried. The booth will need volunteers to cover from 11:00 am to 7:30 pm. Volunteer sheet was circulated at this meeting.

Shirley made iced cakes for this evening's celebration of the Guild's anniversary. Choice of vanilla and chocolate – Thank you Shirley!

Our program for this evening was admiring trunk shows from our own Guild members Teresa, Gaye and Anne Jay.

Tiny Quilts with Anne Jay

Here are April's tiny quilt patterns. Remember, you can add your own interpretation and embellishments and fabric scraps. Tulips, May Flower Basket and a Yo-Yo Wreath tiny quilts to make. If you have any of your tiny quilts completed, please bring them in for show & share. Get creative! Have fun! Keeping you in stitches, Anne

MAY FLOWER BASKET



You can draw each flower as one and add the centers on top

Steam-a-seam works great for tiny quilts.

FLOWERS Block



Cut each tulip in one piece and use stitching to show the inside lines.
You can make every tulip a different colour. Stems and leaves can be different greens as well.

Use some crazy stitching with green thread to add a little grass.

YO-YO WREATH Block (For those brave quilters who like making yo-yos.)

NOTE: For this block you will **NOT** add borders.

Cut your background fabric a 6 1/2" square.

Your finished yo-yo should be no bigger than 3/4" round. You can cut your yo-yo circles from a 2 1/2" square of fabric. OR if you have an extra small size yo-yo maker you are lucky. Applique leaves (remember to add seam allowance if hand-appliqued); or steam-a-seam your leaves and blanket stitch or satin stitch around them.

If you place your leaves so that they form a circle; you will not need to make a fabric center ring.

When placing your wreath pieces remember to leave at least 1/4" around the edge of the background block for the seam allowance.
