And her second project was a double pocket tea bag/Chocolates holder. You can reproduce these projects by watching the instructions on the You Tube Video.




The next Grand Stampers Zoom session will be Saturday, January 20 at 10 AM. Then March 2nd.

Audrey demonstrated and walked us through the assembly of this fun fold card concept.



- 1) A piece of white CS $11'' \times 4 \frac{1}{4}''$ was scored at 2 $\frac{3}{4}''$ and 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- 2) Cut 2 pcs of red CS 5" x 1 ³/₄" each.(Mat)
- 3) One piece of DSP 4 ³/₄" x 1 ¹/₂" and one of embossed white CS 4 ³/₄" x 1 ¹/₂"
 4) Label and decorations (Happy Valentines Day) as you wish.
 - 5) For the inside pop up mechanism cut 2 pcs of white CS
 5" x ¼" each. Score at 1", 2 ½" and 3 ½" and glue two sides of them to the inside of the card as shown. Attach the pink hearts or butterflies.
