Bill Davidson is a resident of Cambridge and has been the Executive Director of Langs since 1985. Bill has a 40 year history working in the Cambridge community and beyond. He has been instrumental in establishing the Langs and North Dumfries Community Health Centres, Community Diabetes Program and Youth Drop-In Centre. Most recently, In 2011, Bill helped to create the Hub@1145, a 58,000 square foot facility that is home to many Langs programs as well as 20 agencies under the same roof. The Langs model has received significant attention in the last year and the Hub has been visited by close to 60 cities representing over 100 different community groups across the province. As an active volunteer, Bill has served on numerous Boards of Directors. He was selected as a recipient of two commemorative medals and an award from the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce to recognize his leadership role in the community. He is also a recipient of a Paul Harris fellowship award from the Rotary Club of Cambridge Sunrise.
