### A MUSICAL GIFT

The Cambridge Symphony Orchestra (CSO) was founded in January 2004 by Ann Green and a team of musicians and non-musicians.

Sabatino Vacca, their current Music Director, assumed leadership in January 2007. The Orchestra performs music throughout the community and provides learning opportunities for musicians at various levels in their musical careers. Sabatino is the Founder, Artistic Director and Chorus Master of the newly formed Southern Ontario Lyric Opera (SOLO). He is also the Music Director of the Etobicoke Philharmonic Orchestra, the Cambridge Symphony Orchestra (CSO), and the newly formed Milton Philharmonic Orchestra. He has conducted orchestras in the Czech Republic as well as in many Ontario cities. Sabatino was on staff with Opera Hamilton and has worked as an opera coach for the University of Toronto, Laurier University, as well as the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto. He is recipient of the Spirit of Ontario Award for the Arts by the National Congress of Italian Canadians.



Joy Schuster received a Bachelor in Music Education from Michigan State University in 1987. Upon graduating she taught as a String Specialist in the Farmington, Maine public schools. She immigrated to Canada in 1989 and taught for the Hamilton School Board and Hamilton Suzuki String School. In 1994 Joy received her Master of Arts in Performance and Suzuki Pedagogy from the University of Denver and before re-locating back to Canada taught in the Grdna Rapids, Michigan Community College Suzuki String program. In 2000 she moved to Cambridge and is presently teaching with the Guelph Suzuki String School. Joy is also Concertmaster with the Cambridge Symphony, violinist with the TomKat Trio and violist with the Stonefields Quartet. She is also co-founder of the Cambridge Youth Symphony and one of their conductors.
